

Vbgooglemap ME 2.5.1 Guide
Document version 1.4



IMPORTANT

VBGooglemap Member Edition 2.5.1 brings you a lot of new features. It's vital that you uninstall any previous version before upgrading/installing version 2.5.1.

As the uninstall function will not remove your googlemap data in the database but only the templates and files you can safely remove an older version. As a precaution you should always take a backup. This should be done on each major change you make to your bulletin board.

IF YOU ARE RUNNING VERSION 1.0.3, 2.0.X AND YOU CHANGED TEXT DIRECTLY IN THE TEMPLATES YOU NEED TO SAVE YOUR CHANGES AS VERSION 2.5.0 REQUIRES YOU TO UNINSTALL PREVIOUS VERSIONS.

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1. Introduction

Welcome to the Vbgooglemap Member Edition installation instructions. This is the standard version of the googlemap for Vbulletin.

The vbgooglemap Member Edition is a design from StonyArc (<http://www.stonyarc.com>). It allows you to create and maintain a map of users that have selected to be on the map. Each usergroup can have a specific colour code. The configuration is done by the administrator.

Clicking on a marker will open a small balloon with some essential elements for that user and a user image in the second tab. Use the menus to navigate through all the functions.

A location/hotspot version is also available on <http://www.vbulletin.org>.

The work is protected and you should leave the copyright marker.

To remove the copyright marker (branding-free running of the application), please get in touch with me on admin@stonyarc.com or on the [vbulletin.org](http://www.vbulletin.org) forum. The email address cannot be used for support questions for this version.

If you have specific requests (eg custom versions) you may use the address to get in touch with me to discuss.

You are allowed to use vbgooglemap Member Edition as long as you observe the following elements:

- Do not remove any of the copyright markers without prior explicit written permission.
- Do not translate the application without prior explicit written permission.
- Do not copy, duplicate or release this application under your own name.
- By posting a marker, you warrant and represent that you have all necessary rights to any text, links, images, photographs or other graphical material contained in the marker and listing.
- Do not abuse the privacy rights of any of the locations or people marked on the map.

Abuse will be reported.

To start with some small guidelines:

- Please following these instructions to the letter
- Upgrading from a previous version will NOT affect the data in the googlemap table
- Tip for upgrade: as a precaution copy your googlemap key to a textfile!!!!
- Enjoy but respect the privacy of your user. As a precaution warn your users of the dangers of displaying their location and advise them to set their marker on a nearby landmark (church, mountain, big building, etc)

3. NEW INSTALLATION

3.1. STEP 1

You'll need a googlemap key for your domain. Get your own key for your domain view <http://www.google.com/apis/maps/signup.html> for more explanation.

NOTE	A googlemap key is only valid for a specific domain. You'll need a specific google account to create one. All is explained on the googlemap link indicated above.
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3.2. STEP 2

Upload the files in the upload folder to the forum root.

NOTE	Make sure you upload the files to the correct folder. If you are running a different style you must upload the images to the correct styles/images directory too to make it work correctly.
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3.3. STEP 3

Set the file permissions on the markers.xml file to 777

3.4. STEP 4

Add product-vbgooglemapme.xml in the backend admin control panel.

3.5. STEP 5

Refresh the full admincp page by clicking refresh/reload. You'll see a **Vbgooglemap ME** link available on the left navigation.

Click the settings link.

Here you'll see the following items

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Auto approve additions to the map (handle with care). Don't forget to allow usergroups to add, edit or delete items in the usergroup manager.	Self explaining
Default map type to show (normal, satellite, hybrid) Normal Hybrid Satellite	This function allows you to set the default map type that will be shown. The on-the-map selection is also available.
Number of items per page in overview list	Self explaining
Googlemap Key for your URL	You'll need a googlemap key for your domain. Get your own key for your domain view http://www.google.com/apis/maps/signup.html for more explanation.
Enable or disable the small map control (disable for better performance)	The new API version from Google supports a small navigation map. This is a nice feature but gives quite high loads. For optimal performance just disable this.
Enable the mouseover support on the markers?	Enabling this will trigger the balloon onmouse over.
Default width of the main map (enter 600 as format)	Self explaining
Default height of the main map (enter 600 as format)	Self explaining
Default zoom of the maps	The overall zoom of the map
Default zoom of the maps when using a link to show the marker	From within the list or details page you can directly click to a location on the map. This is the default zoom for those type of links. Higher zoom as the default zoom for the maps is recommended.
Default latitude for the maps	Self explaining
Default longitude for the maps	Self explaining
Default width for the balloon on marker	Self explaining
Maximum number of chars in the small balloon text	Self explaining (don't set this too high, the details page allows for more information to be entered)
Maximum number of chars in the title	Self explaining (don't set this too high)

3.6. STEP 6

Set the usergroup permissions. By default everything is set to NO

The following settings are available for all usersgroups

- Can view the Googlemap ME
- Can add elements on the Googlemap ME
- Can edit elements on the Googlemap ME
- Can delete elements on the Googlemap ME
- Can edit own entry on the Googlemap ME

Suggestion is to enter to following entries but feel free to setup something else.

NOTE	Go to admincp / Usergroups / Usergroup Manager to set the usergroup permission. To edit the permissions select "Edit Usergroup" and click go. Don't forget to click save on each edit !!!
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3.7. STEP 7

Add a link in the navbar template to vbgooglemapme.php (depends if you want users to see it and when)

NOTE	This is also needed when upgrading because the case of the filename has changed. If you are upgrading a link might already be present. Make sure you enter the correct filename.
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If you want only registered to see it

NOTE	Don't worry, the Vbgooglemap ME application can handle non-registered users. They will only see the main map and won't be able to enter information. Moreover if you specify the usergroup permissions, users that aren't allowed to see the map will get a "not allowed" page.
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3.8. STEP 8

Add the "find me" function to the postbit or where you want to see it.

Open the postbit or the postbit legacy template depending on which one you use

Just add `$post[findme]` where you want the location link to appear in the postbit.

You can add it below the avatar or to a location of your choice.

3.9. STEP 9

Add a scheduled task in the Scheduled Tasks (near plugins)

3.10. STEP 10

Important!!

Test the scheduled task by clicking "Run now" in the Scheduled Task Manager.

If you don't use the test the main map may show empty till someone clicks update or insert on an entry.

Once the initial create is done the other scripts maintain the markers.xml.

UPGRADE FROM PREVIOUS VERSION 1.0.x or 2.0.x

3.11. STEP 1

Uninstall any previous version.

Go to "Manage products" and select uninstall in the select box next to the previous version.

NOTE	As the uninstall function will not remove your googlemap data in the database but only the templates and files you can safely remove an older version. As a precaution you should always take a backup. This should be done on each major change you make to your bulletin board.
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3.12. STEP 2

Remove the old vbgooglemap.php file
Remove the /images/googlemap directory

3.13. STEP 3

Go to step 1 of the new installation process and complete the installation.

4. UPGRADE FROM PREVIOUS VERSION 2.5.x

4.1. STEP 1

Upload all files in the upload directory

4.2. STEP 2

Install the product with overwrite to yes

4.3. STEP 3

Go to step 9 of the new installation process and create the Scheduled Task.
Continue to step 10.

Map location	Click on the correct location. Clicking will place a marker and automatically focus the map on the center. If you make a mistake, just click on the map again the marker will automatically move to the new location.

You can use any other image you want between the links or just use a small text.
